Phase I Environmental Site Assessments

- Identifies Recognized Environmental Conditions
- Completed in general accordance with the current American Society of Testing and Materials (ASTM) International E 1527-13
- Satisfies the "all appropriate inquiry" into the previous ownership and site use
- Includes record reviews, site reconnaissance, interviews, environmental lien search, Vapor Encroachment Condition screening, and report
- Generally performed when a property changes ownership, is used for collateral, or is undergoing refinancing
